PROGRAM INFORMATION

Reyn Franca School is a special day school serving students who are classified as emotionally disturbed, who have acquired socially maladaptive behaviors that do not allow them to meet the behavioral demands, which exist in less restrictive educational settings. For the 2017-18 school year, Reyn Franca School will serve grades K through 12+. There are four classrooms, with a high staff to student ratio of 1:4. The teachers, providing educational services are currently fully credentialed, and the instructional aides are

“Highly Qualified,” as defined by the California Education Code and Federal Mandates. As a result, our educators use a variety of research based strategies and techniques to provide a level of care and service, which is highly regarded by peers and the community. In addition to facilitating services for emotionally disturbed students, Reyn Franca School also meets the needs of students with the following disabilities:

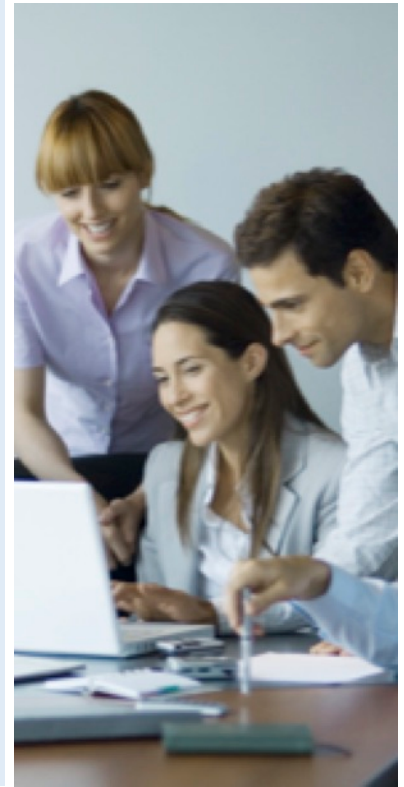

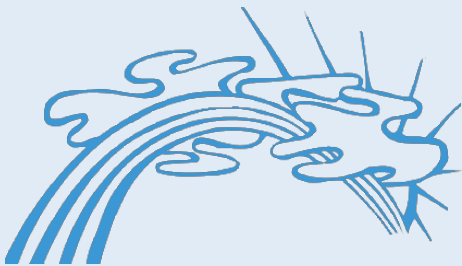
CALIFORNIA STATE TESTING RESULTS
