Grace Bishop School is a special day school serving students who are classified primarily as Emotionally Disturbed and have acquired socially maladaptive behaviors that do not allow them to meet the behavioral demands that exist in less restrictive educational settings.

For the 2018-2019 school year Grace Bishop School, will serve grades K through 12+. There are four classrooms with a high staff to student ratio of 1:4. The teacher s providing educational services are currently fully credential and instructional aides are "Highly Qualified" as

defined by the California Education Code and Federal mandates. As a result, our educators use a variety of researched based strategies and techniques to provide a level of care and service that is highly regarded by peers and the community. In addition to facilitating services for students with emotional disabilities, Grace Bishop School also meets the needs of students with the following disabilities:

A large number of parents/guardians of CAS students chose to opt their students out of assessments in order to alleviate testing anxieties. Also, many of the higher achieving students transition out of Creative Alternatives to access a lesser restrictive environment, thus skewing the availability of results.
